The review panel should consider, but not be limited to, the following issues:

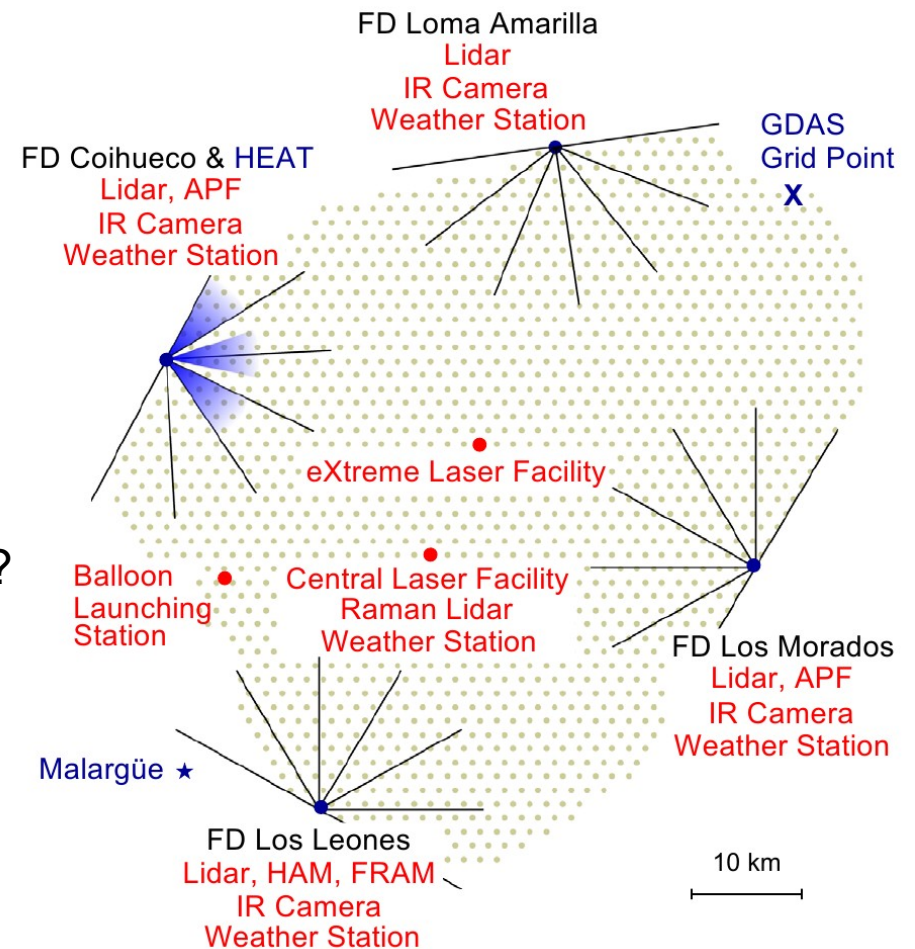
- science provided,
